





Owning Property in Canada

 - Few restrictions
- Where and what are non-residents buying:
 - British Columbia, Ontario & Eastern Canada popular destinations
 - All types of property
 - Vacation, 2nd home and investment
- MLS® systems cover the entire country

Vacation and recreational properties in Canada

Canada is a destination of choice for vacation properties. The country's diverse geography and topography are ideal for sports enthusiasts, nature lovers, wildlife aficionados and more. Owning recreational property in Canada can come with some special conditions or requirements: a REALTOR® specialized in these types of properties could help sort through details such as water rights, environmental laws and the types of inspections required and provide referrals to professionals in these areas.

Transaction Process - What's Different



THE RESIDENTIAL TRANSACTION PROCESS IN BRIEF

Below is a high-level, simplified view of what a residential transaction process could look like in Canada. Remember that every transaction is unique.

REALTOR® looks for properties that match buyer criteria
Financial requirements for the pending purchase are addressed by the buyer — sufficient funds are available in a Canadian financial institution
Buyer reviews photographs and listing information on REALTOR.ca or visits potential properties with their REALTOR®
REALTOR®, on behalf of their client will make an offer to purchase on the specific property, negotiate price, conditions and will also assist with recommending any property inspections
Through their respective REALTORS®, buyer and seller agree on a conditional contract of sale subject to conditions such as securing financing, home inspection, etc.
If all the conditions are fulfilled by the specified date then the sale is finalized
Buyer secures a lawyer (notary in Quebec), who receives all necessary documents to perform a title search and register the buyer as owner of the property
Purchase, disbursement and commission fees and taxes are paid [normally handled by lawyer (notary in Quebec) in conjunction with REALTOR®]

THE COMMERCIAL TRANSACTION PROCESS IN BRIEF

This is a similarly high-level view of what the commercial transaction process could like in Canada.

PROPERTY SEARCH	REALTOR® looks for properties that match buyer criteria
PROVISIONAL FINANCING	Financial requirements for the pending purchase are addressed by the buyer — sufficient funds are available in a Canadian financial institution
ZONING AND REGULATORY CHECK	REALTOR® confirms zoning of property is eligible for permitted uses; if the site is "brownfield" (i.e., already existing), provincial environment authorities may also need to be consulted
OFFER TO PURCHASE	Buyer makes an offer through his or her REALTOR® to purchase a specific property, negotiating price, conditions, inspections and REALTOR® recommends appropriate inspections for type of property
CONDITIONAL SALE	Through their respective REALTORS®, buyer and seller agree on a conditional contract of sale and the buyer secures a lawyer (notary in Quebec) to handle the final details
FINAL SALE	Building and property inspections occur; financing arranged; lawyer (notary in Quebec) checks for outstanding property issues (e.g., government work orders, liens)
TITLE SEARCH AND REGISTRATION	Lawyer (notary in Quebec) receives all necessary documents to perform a title search and register the buyer as owner of the property
CLOSING	Purchase, disbursement and commission fees and taxes are paid [normally handled by lawyer (notary in Quebec) in conjunction with REALTOR®]










Inbound - Global Interest in Canada









Where are Canadians Looking?






Outbound – US Research – Residential Activity
